



# Governing Board Remuneration

## as per the Local Arrangements Agreement 2010 – 2015

Signed December 17, 2013, the Local Arrangements Agreement allows for remuneration for support staff for time served on Governing Board Committees. The accepted clause is retroactive to December 17, 2013. Support staff members serving on the Governing Board Committee cannot be asked by their supervisor/administrator to put the time toward the required compensatory time. This is a benefit extended to the employee for sitting on the committee and it is his/her choice to take the time off at his/her choosing, with the agreement of the supervisor/administrator, or be paid (by having an OER form completed and sent to the Payroll Department).

The Local Agreement clause reads as follows:

### **4-2.00**

#### **Governing Board Committee**

An employee called on to participate in a committee relating to Governing Board may be absent from work without loss of salary in order to take part in the meetings after having informed his or her immediate supervisor. However, if the meetings take place outside of working hours, the employee shall be remunerated in time equal to the hours of the duration of the meeting, or money at the basic hourly rate.
